Since 2024, Micron has reported on a semi-annual basis its direct and indirect political giving activities including corporate contributions to state and local candidates, parties, and committees; contributions to federal candidates by the Micron Employee Political Action Committee (Micron Employee PAC); and other corporate contributions such as ballot measures or independent political expenditures.
